

SUBMITTING A PROGRAM FOR REVIEW to the Title IV-E Prevention Services Clearinghouse

The [Title IV-E Prevention Services Clearinghouse](#) will continue to review programs and services, including those submitted through a public call for recommendations. Their website provides basic information on the review process on their [web page of frequently asked questions](#). The Clearinghouse offers a [Reporting Guide for Study Authors](#) for organizations submitting a program or service for review.

Identification of Programs to Review

Programs and services will be identified from the following sources:

- A public call for recommendations on at least an annual basis. The first public call occurred in the fall of 2019. The second call closed on October 5, 2020.
- Recommendations received in response to the 2018 FRN and from federal partners and other key stakeholders.
- An environmental scan and an inventory of the literature.

The Clearinghouse keeps a list of [programs and services scheduled for review](#) in the areas of mental health, substance abuse, in-home parent skill-based programs, and kinship navigator. Ratings are released on a rolling basis as reviews are completed.

At the end of the review process, programs and services are rated as well supported, supported, promising, or does not currently meet criteria. Programs can be re-reviewed if there was missing information or errors in the original review, or if there is new evidence that could change the ratings.

Eligibility for Review

To be eligible for review, programs and services must:

Address at least one of the four program or service areas:

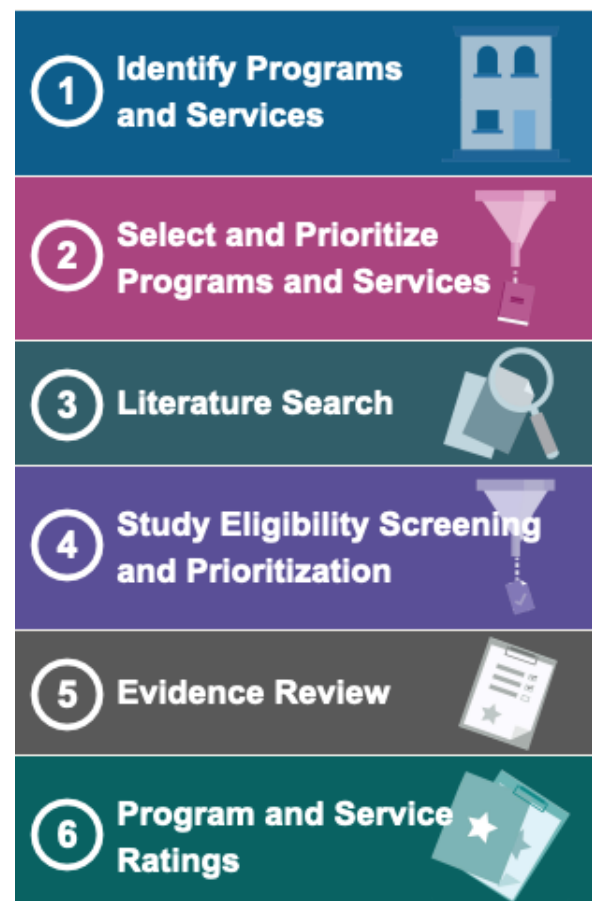
- Mental health prevention and treatment programs or services
- Substance abuse prevention and treatment programs or services
- In-home parent skill-based programs or services
- Kinship navigator programs

Include a book, manual, or writings.

Programs and services must be clearly defined and replicable. They must have written protocols, manuals, or other documentation that describes how to implement or administer the practice.

Review Process
