

# MPH/DPT Dual Degree

At the University of Montana, students can earn a dual degree in just three years: a Doctor of Physical Therapy and a Master of Public Health, thanks to our unique credit exchange agreement.

Applicants who are interested in a dual degree program *must* apply to and be admitted by the DPT program before applying to the MPH program.

### Admission Process

Step 1: Complete Online Application https://gradapply.umt.edu/register/gradapply

Step 2: Request Official Transcript(s) Will be collected from your PT application.

#### Step 3: Three Letters of Recommendation Will be collected from your PT application.

Step 4: Current Resume Include all work experience with dates of employment.

Step 5: Personal Statement
