Foundations (15 Credits)


Graduate foundations available for individuals without a business undergrad degree.

19 required credits



Electives

4 credits from a variety options. 9 Credits will be applied from the PT program to the MBA electives.

- Weekend courses
- 5-week flex delivery / online courses

Graduate Program Admission Process

Step 1: Complete Online Application

Complete the online application: https://gradapply.umt.edu/register/gradapply

Step 2: Request Official Transcript(s)

We will collect your official transcripts from your PT application.

 If an undergraduate degree was earned from the University of Montana, we do not require official transcript(s) to be submitted.

Step 3: Three Letters of Recommendation

We will collect your Recommendations from your PT application.

Step 4: Current Resume

Include all work experience with dates of employment.

Step 5: Letter of Intent

Address letter to the Review Committee, 2-3 paragraphs in standard business format, no longer than 1 page.

• Describe your objective for receiving a graduate degree to include your career highlights, achievements, and goals.

Scholarship, Graduate Assistant and Career Development

Scholarship

Over \$540,000 in scholarships awarded to business students for the 2023/2024 academic year. Applications for 2024 opens December 1, 2023, and are due March 1, 2024.

Qualifications

- Apply to a graduate program by the first week of February
- Enrolled or plan to enroll (6 credits per semester minimum) during the upcoming academic year
- Complete an online scholarship application by March 1st.

Graduate Assistantship

6 - 8 positions awarded per academic year

Oualifications

- Admitted or applied to the graduate programs by February 1st.
- Outstanding academic record
- Graduate Assistant application submitted by March 1st.

Benefits

- Tuition support (University and College of Business's fees not included)
- \$5,000 per semester stipend

Requirements

- Work 20 hours per week for assigned faculty members
- Maintain a minimum of 6 credits per semester and good academic standing
